We wish you a Merry Christmas!

In the Gospel of Luke 1:26-56 you will find the incredible account of how Mary was notified through the angel Gabriel of being chosen to give birth to the Son of God, Jesus. A selection of the words of Scripture:

28 The angel went to her and said, "Greetings, you who are highly favored! The Lord is with you." 29 Mary was greatly troubled at his words and wondered what kind of greeting this might be. 30 But the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary; you have found favor with God. 31 You will conceive and give birth to a son, and you are to call him Jesus. 32 He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. The Lord God will give him the throne of his father David, 33 and he will reign over Jacob's descendants forever; his kingdom will never end."

34 "How will this be," Mary asked the angel, "since I am a virgin?"

35 The angel answered, "The Holy Spirit will come on you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. So the holy one to be born will be called the Son of God.

Mary was a young, poor female-all characteristics that to the people of her day, would make her seem unusable to God. But God chose Mary for one of the most important acts of obedience he has ever demanded of anyone. And what a demand it was! Mary had to process the request and follow with all her heart mind and soul.

This calendar year, 2020, has made many demands that are out of the ordinary upon all of us. For parents of young children, it has meant keeping them safe as well as providing an avenue for them to prosper and learn, while patience is stretched to the limit. For children, it has meant not being able to interact with their friends and family. For a generation who is older in their years, it is fear of a pandemic that is causing more adverse effect than other age groups. But really every generation has been touched as well as our lifestyle and economy.

Look closely at Mary's question to Gabriel (God) found in verse 34: "*How will this be*?" I can imagine she is really saying there is no way – I can't do this and it's not possible! God gave Mary the answer she needed and the answer we need today to cope in all circumstances: Vs35: "*The Holy Spirit will come on you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you*."

As we finish this year and celebrate the birth of the Messiah under pandemic circumstances, nothing has changed. As Christians, we have the Holy Spirit who is willing and ready to unleash the power of God in you. This power will never leave you, trouble you, disappoint you, or give up on you. This year, you may have to find new ways to celebrate the birth of our Savior, but make sure you receive Him so that God's power might provide Hope, Joy, Love, and Peace in your life.
